Founded in 1965, ECVC is a successful self-sustaining nonprofit 501(c)(3) agency that holds more than a dozen federal contracts for hundreds of items across multiple product lines. We are one of the largest suppliers of batteries to the United States Military. We are a prime manufacturer of picture frames and battery terminal adapters. Other federal packaging contracts include pipe cleaners, drill bits, pushpins, and thumbtacks. We partner with a variety of commercial businesses from around the world to handle their warehousing, packaging, assembly, manufacturing, and shipping needs.

- 99% on-time shipping rate for the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) since 1993
- Over 40,000 total orders shipped annually, with average turnaround time of less than one day
- Over 60 million batteries shipped annually
- 120,000 square feet of climate-controlled warehouse and production space
- 7 dock doors
- 132 bays with minimum of 1,256 single-stacked pallet spaces
- Securable, fork-lift accessible isolation rooms available
- Production equipment includes forklifts, pallet jacks, vacuum lift systems, Gerber cutting table, multi-station blister packaging machine, computerized stretch wrap machine, gantry crane and high-capacity label printers with military-grade functionality

 - o 99 miles from RDU International Airport
 - o 5 miles from Interstate 587, and 1 mile from US Highway 264 bypass

 - Approximately a two-hour drive from three major shipping ports (Norfolk, Morehead City, Wilmington)

- On-site job placement and staffing service, so we can staff up quickly for new on or offsite opportunities.
- Partnering with Employment and Independence of People with Disabilities (EIPD, formerly Vocational Rehabilitation VR) and Pitt County Schools to offer Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) for high school students with disabilities.
- Partnering with East Carolina University (ECU) and Pitt Community College (PCC) to offer permanent scholarships for students with disabilities.
